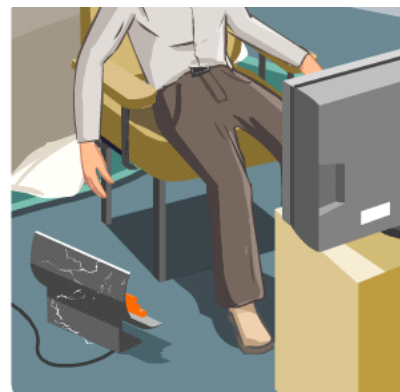
In this activity, you'll be presented with photos of care environments and you'll need to identify any fire hazards present.

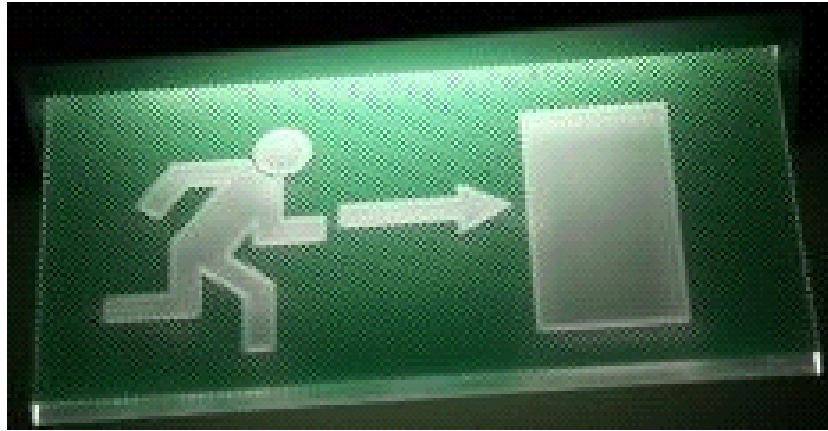
