NHS Continuing Healthcare



About NHS Continuing Healthcare

NHS Continuing Healthcare is fully funded care for adults aged 18 or over who have a primary health need with care provided over an extended period of time.

- People with short episodes of ill health are not normally considered for NHS Continuing Healthcare.
- Where a person is not eligible for NHS Continuing Healthcare they may still be entitled to other types of healthcare support.
- Even if considered eligible, a person's entitlement to funding does not necessarily last indefinitely.
- Key features of the approach include:
 - Care is fundamentally person-centred;
 - The emphasis on careful handling of personal data (see the NHS Confidentiality Code of Practice);
 - The 'care co-ordination' approach;
 - The use of the Decision Support Tool as a robust method for assessing eligibility.
- Screening is used to help plan care and enable fast tracking of someone who needs their eligibility for NHS Continuing Healthcare to be considered urgently.
- The 5-stage Assessment Process underpinning NHS Continuing Healthcare:
 - Step 1: identify potential candidates
 - Step 2: conduct comprehensive needs assessment
 - Step 3: make eligibility decision
 - Step 4: write care plan
 - Step 5: monitor and review
