- Style and dress hair to achieve a variety of creative looks
- Style and dress long hair
- Provide colour correction services
- Perm hair using a variety of techniques
- Colour hair using a variety of techniques
- Provide correcting relaxing services
- Create complex styles using African Caribbean styling techniques
- Style hair using locking techniques
- Provide Indian head massage treatment
- Support customer service improvements
- Contribute to the financial effectiveness of the business
- Contribute to the planning and implementation of promotional activities
