

Youth Work NVQ Level 2



The Youth Work NVQ is designed for youth support workers helping young people aged between 11 and 25 to develop personally and socially. Endorsed by the National Youth Agency as appropriate qualifications for youth support workers, they are aimed at people working in a range of settings with young people. These can vary from youth clubs and centres, to schools, colleges and voluntary youth organisations.

The NVQ requires the achievement of 6 units of competence based on the National Occupational Standards for Youth Work.

Mandatory Units

- Establish relationships and maintain dialogue with your people
- Work as an effective and reflective partner
- Work in ways that promote equality of opportunity, participation and responsibility
- Work with young people to safeguard their welfare

Optional Units— choose 3

- Enable young people to access and use information and make decisions
- Enable young people to be active citizens
- Support young people in tackling problems and taking action
- Advocate on behalf of young people
- Enable young people to develop awareness of their self-identity and being
- Work with young people to design and develop sessions
- Work with young people to manage resources of events, activities or projects
- Review progress and evaluate opportunities with young people

Mandatory Units

- Enable young people to explore and develop their values and self respect
- Enable young people to work effectively in groups
- Enable young people to use their learning to enhance their future development
- Manage your work and create effective work relationships

Optional Units— 2 must be completed from Group A and 2 from Group B

Group A:

- Enable young people to access and use information and make decisions
- Enable young people to be active citizens
- Support young people in tackling problems and taking action
- Advocate on behalf of young people
- Enable young people to develop awareness of their self-identity and being
- Work with young people to design and develop sessions
- Work with young people to manage resources for events, activities or projects
- Review progress and evaluate opportunities with young people

Group B:

- Investigate needs and provision for young people and promote youth work opportunities
- Identify relationships with other organisations and individuals
- Build and maintain partnership work
- Provide information to aid policy formation, and the improvement of practices and provision
- Develop teams and individuals to enhance the quality of youth work
- Promote a culture of Health and Safety
